## 20 years of Lisbon Recognition, 20 years of UK NARIC

11 April marked 20 years of the Lisbon Recognition Convention - the 'Convention on the Recognition of Qualifications in Higher Education in the European Region' - adopted on that date in 1997 and since ratified by 53 states.

April 2017 is also the 20th anniversary of UK NARIC as the national agency performing the official qualification recognition function for the UK. A publication to celebrate the milestone, looking at some of the current issues in recognition and developments worldwide, will be issued later in the year.

UK NARIC's Katherine Latta was a keynote speaker at the University of Mainz in Germany on 11 April, at a Lisbon anniversary conference exploring the future of recognition (*pictured below: a 'visual minute' of conference contributions*).

UK NARIC has signed an agreement (*signing ceremony above*) with the DataFlow Group, a global provider of background screening and immigration compliance services, to deliver primary source verification (PSV) of qualifications and other documentation.
